1.1 Introduction

This website together with any of our other websites including our various top-level domains as well as various sub-domains and aliases of these domains (the “**Website**”) is operated by EventElephant Limited (“**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”). We have created this Privacy Statement in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to privacy. The following discloses our information gathering and dissemination practices relating to this Website. In order to fully understand your rights, we encourage you to read this Privacy Statement and to consult our Terms and Conditions of Use and, if applicable to you our Terms and Conditions for Event Organisers and our Terms and Conditions for Event Attendees (the “**Terms**”). Each time you use this Website you will be bound by the then current Privacy Statement and you should review this each time you use the website to satisfy yourself that you are happy with it.

This Privacy Statement sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

If you are an Event Organiser (as defined in section 1.6 below), for the purpose of the Data Protection Acts 1988 and 2003, the data controller is EventElephant Limited, an Irish company registered under company number 452571 with its registered address at 56 Lansdowne Road, Dublin 4, Ireland.

If you are attending an event organised through the Website, the data controller is the Event Organiser of that event. In this case, we act as a data processor on behalf of the Event Organiser.

EventElephant Limited is registered with the Data Protection Commissioner in Ireland as a data controller and a data processor (Registration Number 10450/A).

1.2 Acceptance of this Privacy Statement

By using this Website and services, you signify acceptance of this Privacy Statement. If you do not agree with or you are not comfortable with any aspect of the Privacy Statement, your only remedy is to discontinue use of the Website. We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Statement at any time. Your continued use of any portion of the Website following notification or posting of such changes will constitute your acceptance of those changes.

1.3 Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide to us when using this Website. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use this Website, subscribing to our services or purchasing goods, posting material or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you enter a competition or promotion sponsored by us and when you report a problem with the Website.
- If you contact us for any reason, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.

- Details of transactions through the Website to which you are a party and of the fulfilment of your orders.

The Event Organiser (as defined in section 1.6 below) of your event may request specific/additional information from you regarding your attendance at an event. Any such information is not available to us.

1.4 Where we store your personal data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area (“**EEA**”). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Statement.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL technology. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our Website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Website; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

1.5 Uses made of your information

We use information held about you:

- To ensure that content from our Website is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our Website.
- To notify you about changes to our Website and/or services.

If you are an existing customer, we will only contact you by electronic means (such as email, voicemail or SMS) with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale to you.

If you do not want us to use your data in this way please tick the relevant boxes when we collect your marketing preferences. You may change your preferences at any time by accessing the 'Edit Profile' section of your organiser account on the [website](#) and amending your preferences accordingly.

We do not, without your consent, disclose information about identifiable individuals to third parties, but we may send anonymised statistical data to them for research and survey purposes. We may also

use such information to help advertisers reach the kind of audience they want to target. We may make use of the personal data we have collected from you to enable us to comply with our advertisers' wishes by displaying their advertisement to that target audience.

1.6 Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to any member of the EventElephant Group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries.

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If we or substantially all of our assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by us about our customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our Terms and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of us and our group companies, our customers, or others. This may include exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
- If you are attending an event organised through our Website, in which case we will provide personal data you provide to us to the event organiser, venue, promoter, performer, sponsoring organisation, or other involved third party ("**Event Organiser**") to ensure the successful organisation of that event.

We make no warranty or representation as to how Event Organisers may use or continue to use your data collected through the Website. Please note that Event Organisers will have their own data protection procedures and policies and we do not accept any responsibility or liability for these procedures and policies.

The use of this Website by minors under the age of 16 is subject to the consent of their parent or guardian. We advise parents or guardians who permit their children to use the Internet that it is important that they communicate with their children about their safety online.

1.7 Security

We take your online security very seriously and this Website has security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control. However, as no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed as 100% secure, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us and you transfer the data at your own risk. We endeavour to use appropriate technical and organisational measures in order to secure the confidentiality of your personal data, to prevent unauthorised or unlawful processing of such personal data, and to protect against accidental or unlawful destruction, accidental loss, alteration or unauthorised disclosure or access and to otherwise protect the security of such personal data.

1.8 Cookies

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about how you browse our Website.

For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general Internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies help us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalised service. They enable us:

- To estimate usage numbers and patterns.
- To store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customise our Website according to your individual interests.
- To speed up your searches.
- To recognise you when you return to our Website.

You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of the Website or unable to avail of any of our services. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our Website.
